works to increase Florida products served in schools, offer healthier options for Florida's children and get students involved in nutrition and agriculture education through school garden activities.



During the **2024-2025** school year, Florida schools purchased over for the following in Florida products.



Florida districts purchased almost \$8.2 MILLION in Florida fruits and vegetables, representing more than 5.7 MILLION POUNDS of Florida produce.



Schools spent approximately \$2.3 MILLION through the USDA's DOD Program and \$5.9 MILLION thorough LFS grants.





Nearly \$82,000 of Florida beef products were sourced for school meals, representing more than 21 THOUSAND POUNDS of meat and 517 dozen eggs.



Cafeterias served \$51.3 MILLION worth of local milk, which equates to almost 179 MILLION HALF PINTS.
